

METHOD OF ELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Election Officer. The Pratt County Clerk shall be the election officer for all USD No. 382 elections.

Election Dates. General Elections for Board members are held on the first Tuesday in April. Primary elections, if required, are held on the Tuesday five weeks prior to the general election. An election will be held in 1975 and every four years thereafter for those positions expiring in that year, including the seventh appointive member. An election will be held in 1973 and every four years thereafter for the remaining positions.

Candidates. A candidate must meet the residence requirements for an elector of the district and must file for office with the Pratt County Clerk. The candidate may file either by paying the required filing fee or by presenting a petition signed by the number of electors as required by statute. Said fee or petition must be submitted prior to 12:00 noon on the Tuesday which precedes the first Tuesday in April of odd numbered years by ten weeks.

Conduct of the election shall be as provided in Article 20 of Kansas Statutes Annotated and other pertinent acts of the legislature.
