

## BOARD COMMITTEES

The board shall operate at all times as a committee of the whole.

There shall be no standing or temporary committees except as otherwise provided for in these policies.

The board shall, from time to time, establish such advisory committees as it deems necessary. The type and function of each advisory committee shall be dictated by the needs of the district for the special services of each such committee. The board shall appoint all members of all advisory committees, excepting the Rural Advisory. Each such advisory committee shall organize itself with assistance from the superintendent. The superintendent shall provide appropriate district material to each committee.

No direct financial assistance shall be furnished any committee without the prior approval of the board.

A line of communication shall be established between each committee and the superintendent and the board.

Each committee shall keep minutes of each meeting and report to the superintendent and/or board as the board may require by regulation or by other means.

Whenever, in the opinion of the board, there is no longer any need for an advisory committee created by the board, the board shall dissolve such committee by appropriate board action. Each member of the committee shall be notified of the board's action, together with an appropriate expression of appreciation from the board for the committee member's efforts. No committee shall exist longer than one year.
