

BOARD - SUPERINTENDENT RELATIONS

Authorities in the field of education agree that the legislation of policies is the most important function of a school board, and that the execution of the policies should then be the function of the superintendent.

The laws of Kansas provide for the board of education to design policies such as these for the governance of the school district. The laws further provide for the board to select a superintendent who shall have charge and control of the schools.

Delegation by the board of its executive powers provides freedom for the superintendent to manage the schools within established policies. The superintendent should then be held responsible by the board for results.
