HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

All Pratt High School students must have the High School Principal's approval before enrolling and

attending at the Community College during the normal school day. Approval may be granted to juniors

and seniors by the principal based on various factors such as student's high school grades and

performance, student's ability to benefit from college work, and the need for advanced work. A student

must be 16 years old prior to the beginning of the semester of enrollment.

High school juniors and seniors may:

1. Enroll in up to six (1-6) college hours if they are attending high school five (5) periods

per day.

2. Enroll in seven to nine (7-9) college hours if they are attending high school four (4)

periods per day.

Juniors or seniors requesting enrollment at Pratt Community College shall have the completed request

form IHG-R (form follows this section) seven (7) days prior to the beginning of a semester in which they

plan to attend.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT BETWEEN PRATT HIGH SCHOOL AND THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

With the principal's approval, juniors and seniors may enroll in appropriate concurrent course offerings

which are offered at the Pratt High School campus in cooperation with Pratt Community College.

Note: Students identified by IEP's may have exceptions from the above policy. Such exceptions will be

identified by federal and state laws.
