

TEST SELECTION AND ADOPTION

Pratt U.S.D. 382's testing program shall include a sequence of intelligence, achievement and other tests, mandated by KSDE, administered as follows:

1. CTBS Achievement test to all students in the following grade levels:
 - a. 2nd Grade b. 4th Grade e. 11th Grade
 - c. 6th Grade d. 9th Grade

2. Otis-Lennon Mental Ability test to all students in the following grade levels:
 - a. Kindergarten c. 7th Grade
 - b. 3rd grade

3. The Explore test is optional to students in the following grade level:
 - a. 8th Grade

4. The Plan test is optional to students in the following grade level:
 - a. 10th Grade

5. PSAT national Merit test is optional to students in the following grade level:
 - a. 11th Grade b. 12th Grade

6. American College Testing Program, "ACT", is optional to students in the following grade levels:
 - a. 11th Grade b. 12th Grade

7. Scholastic Aptitude Test, "SAT", is optional to students in the following grade level:
 - a. 11th b. 12th Grade

State Assessments will be used where appropriate and in compliance with current state department guidelines.

A district-wide testing committee appointed by the Superintendent of Schools shall function on the premise that continuous communication will establish the best thinking of all personnel concerned with testing.

The purpose of the district-wide testing committee shall be to recommend policies, review the present testing program, advise in determining procedures and to assist in coordinating the testing program kindergarten through grade twelve.
