

**PHS CLASS OF 1960 ALUMNI  
\$5,000 SCHOLARSHIP  
APPLICATION**

The Pratt High School Class of 1960 will award, through the Pratt High School Alumni Association at least one \$5,000 scholarship to a member of the Pratt High graduation class of 2010. The Class of 1960 may award an additional scholarship/s of varying amounts.

**Terms of the scholarship:**

Applicants must possess at least a 2.5 senior high school grade point average and establish a financial need. This scholarship will be administered by the PHS Alumni Association and paid to the college or university of the recipient's choice and applied to their expenses in equal amounts for each of eight semesters (payable on August 15 and January 15).

In the event the recipient chooses to attend Pratt Community College, the award may be deferred and pro-rated per semester for the remaining college years.

**College academic standards:**

The recipient must maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average until graduation. The recipient must send a copy of his/her grades to the Pratt High School Alumni Association Board of Directors at the end of each semester.

**Termination:**

If the recipient fails to maintain the required grade point average or terminates their schooling at any time for any reason the scholarship shall cease. The college or university shall make any refund or unused monies payable directly to the Pratt High School Alumni Association.

Applicants are requested to complete the attached application form and submit it to the Counselor's Office no later than April 1<sup>st</sup>. Upon submission of this application the privacy of the applicant and family will be protected by separating the top page of the application and assigning each applicant a number. The selection committee will not know the name of the applicant or their family.
