HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

All Pratt High School students must have the High School Principal's approval before enrolling at the Community College.

During their senior year, high school students may:

- 1. Enroll in three (3) college hours if they are attending high school six (6) periods per day.
- 2. Enroll in five to six (5-6) college hours if they are attending high school five (5) periods per day.
- 3. Enroll in nine (9) college hours if they are attending high school four (4) periods per day.

Request form IHG-R shall be used by students wishing to receive this approval.

HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Seniors requesting enrollment at Pratt Community College for the second semester shall have the completed request form (form follows this section) in the Principal's office seven (7) days prior to the opening of the second semester of their senior year.

Seniors attending Pratt Senior High School and Pratt Community College concurrently shall schedule their High School courses in consecutive hours. They may be of any four consecutive hour combinations.
