STUDENT SERVICES PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY

Pratt- USD 382 recognizes the importance of meaningful parent involvement in student progress. To this end, parent contact with the school is always encouraged. Additionally, Pratt - USD #382 makes the following commitments to parent involvement:

- Each K-8 school will conduct, at least annually, parent meetings wherein parents will be informed of available student services (including state/federal programs), requirements of such, curriculum overview, school performance toward standards, and parental rights.
- The high school will distribute information to parents on an annual basis regarding available student services including requirements, curriculum, school performance toward standards, and parental rights.
- Every school site council will conduct an annual review of student services (including state/federal programs). Site councils will recommend and plan for program improvements and modifications as deemed necessary for the building and within federal, state, and district guidelines. Site councils will use continuous school improvement methodology for program evaluation.
- Student progress toward outcomes and performance on individual assessments, will be shared with parents on a quarterly basis at all attendance centers. Parent conferences will be conducted through district-wide scheduling of biannual conferences at grades Pre-K through 5 and annual conferences at grades 6-12. Additional conferences will be conducted at the request of parents, students or staff.
- Parents will be provided with opportunities to improve upon their parenting skills as caregivers, tutors, and advocates for their children through parent inservice opportunities at the building and district level.

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
