STUDENT OUT-OF-STATE TRIPS

Periodically an individual student will receive an invitation or qualify because of club activities for an outof-state meeting. The Board of Education is of the opinion that such trips should be kept to a minimum in order to assure that the academic program of each student is not seriously affected. However, the Board recognizes the value of such out-of-state trips and will provide fifty percent (50%) of the travel expense for such trips providing:

- 1. All Trips have prior Board of Education approval.
- 2. All other expenses including the remaining portion of the transportation are paid by the student.
- 3. All such trips are for individual students and not a class or grade.
- 4. Loss of class time is kept to a minimum.
- 5. All such trips are directly involved with the student's school activities and have the sanction of the State Department of Education and/or the High School Activities Association.
