

STUDENT OUT-OF-STATE TRIPS

Periodically an individual student will receive an invitation or qualify because of club activities for an out-of-state meeting. The Board of Education is of the opinion that such trips should be kept to a minimum in order to assure that the academic program of each student is not seriously affected. However, the Board recognizes the value of such out-of-state trips and will provide fifty percent (50%) of the travel expense for such trips providing:

1. All Trips have prior Board of Education approval.
2. All other expenses including the remaining portion of the transportation are paid by the student.
3. All such trips are for individual students and not a class or grade.
4. Loss of class time is kept to a minimum.
5. All such trips are directly involved with the student's school activities and have the sanction of the State Department of Education and/or the High School Activities Association.
