

## TITLE I PROGRAMS

The board shall ensure that the district's Title I program operate in accordance with federal laws and conditions. The superintendent is responsible for administering the district's Title I program, assessing the educational needs of all students, particularly the needs of educationally disadvantaged children; developing appropriate communication channels between all parties, to the extent practicable, providing full opportunities for the participation of parents/guardians with limited English proficiency, parents/guardians with disabilities, and parents/guardians of migrant children, including providing information and school reports required under federal law in a format and language such parents/guardians can understand; developing inservice training for parents and staff; and developing appropriate evaluation procedures.

### Annual Parent Meeting

The board shall designate at least one meeting date each school year to provide parents of Title I students an opportunity to meet with school personnel in order to participate in the design and implementation of the Title I program.
