EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM (See IC, ID and II)

The superintendent may develop guidelines to evaluate the instructional program. This evaluation may be part of the district's school improvement efforts.

The superintendent may establish special curriculum committees to study the district's instructional program on a regular schedule. The superintendent may require reports from these committees which may_include the committee's recommendations for improvement, modification or elimination of any part of the instructional program. The superintendent may submit a comprehensive report from the committees to the board.
