

KSHSAA CONCUSSION REQUIREMENT FOR 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR FOR ALL PHS ATHLETES (including cheerleaders)

All student athletes (including managers) are required to have the KSHSAA Concussion On-Line Class completion certificate on file in the Athletic Office prior to participating in practice on August 17, 2026. This individualized class needs to be completed once during a student's PHS career. After completion, a student must complete a review each and every year. (See next paragraph)

Many of the Pratt upperclassmen have completed the individualized class requirement. These students must do one of the following:

- Watch the review concussion video in May 2026 weightlifting class
- Watch the review concussion video during laptop checkout in August
- Re-complete the KSHSAA Concussion On-Line Class and submit a new certificate.

DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE STUDENT CONCUSSION ON-LINE REQUIREMENT

ALL PHS athletes need to watch the NFHS "Concussion for Students" video and complete required documentation before attending practice starting August 17, 2026. This includes all managers. Please count on a minimum of 1 hour to complete the process. Here are the directions to complete the course:

1. Log on to www.nfhslearn.com and register a free account if you already don't have one.
2. Then go to courses, search for the course titled "Concussion for Students."
3. It will require you to purchase the course, but there is no fee to purchase it.
4. Watch the interactive video and complete the questions.
5. At the end of the course you will be given the option to print a Certificate of completion. This certificate will serve as documentation of completion. Print the certificate as a PDF file and please e-mail it to chris.battin@usd382.com or the athletic secretary. Also, it is recommended you email it to yourself for your own records. Another option will be to take a screenshot of your Certificate of completion.
6. After receipt of the certificate of completion by Mr. Battin or the Athletic Secretary, you have completed the Concussion requirement. The date on the certificate of completion must be after April 1, 2026
